## Finance Report:

Diana presented the July 2022 Statements with Notes. Additionally provided June Unaudited statements for informational purposes only.

#### **Election of CDS Board Members:**

Gil Levy, Debby Kinman-Ford, Dr. Robert Thomas, Veita Jackson-Carter, M.Ed. No objections. All in favor. All four new Board Members elected.

Paige Beck to be inquired regarding Advisory Board interest.

Ratification – Philip Kabler as Registered Agent. Motion passed.

### Asset repair expense ratification:

CDS IYP-E emergency stove/refrigerator replacement (\$3,077.25). Motion passed.

#### FY 22/23 Budget:

Phil explained the CINS/FINS changes; that budget includes assumption of 100% of the contracts are earned, the minimum salary is \$15 per hour and some increases for critical positions. Tommy- We are faced with an unfunded mandate. We had a false sense of security during the COVID years as we were being paid  $1/12^{th}$  the contract. Everyone in Florida is in the same boat. Tommy suggested Richard and Cindy work together on alternative products and services for grant income, i.e.: after school remedial help.

Richard - We knew this mandate was coming, and wanted to do it sooner, but could not afford it.

Phil - We have sold two buildings on 6<sup>th</sup> Street. The Arlington, Lake City building is listed for sale. Tommy has instructed that half the proceeds be allocated toward operating and the other half toward reserve.

Motion: The Budget & Finance/Executive Committee recommend approval of the Budget for 2022-2023. Tommy empowered Daniel to place the building for sale on 620 SW Arlington Blvd, Lake City. Becky Hunt 2<sup>nd</sup>. No Objections. All in favor. Motion passed.

### **CINS/FINS Deliverables Update:**

Cindy reported that in August we were above expectations in all areas, and should meet 100% of the contract. The flooding event in the Central Shelter put us a bit behind. The Florida Network was kept informed and were very supportive.

### **Program Reports:**

## **Rebranding Committee:**

Frank thanked Paula and members of the Committee for their hard work. Paula presented a slide show of changes for logo, terms corresponding to 'CDS', and updated Mission Statement. Tommy suggested further review of the logo with Veita Jackson-Carter.

Beck Hunt 2<sup>nd</sup>. No Objections. All in favor. Motions passed.

Motion: To have CDS buy polo shirts and Board members may reimburse CDS if they choose. No Objections. All in favor. Motions passed.

Motion: To create six minute video for WUFT Greater Good programming. The cost is \$500. Motion passed.

Paula – We also have a lighthouse art competition and would like the Board to choose the top 3 works to be exhibited at the Annual Meeting.
